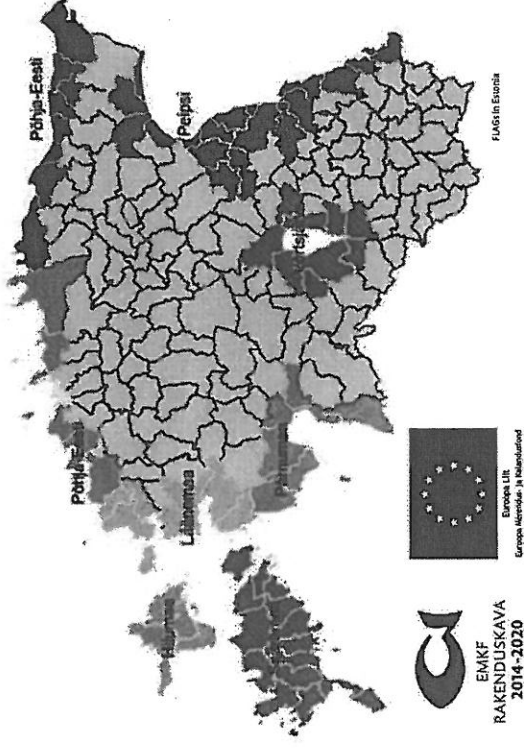

- 20 Local Municipalities

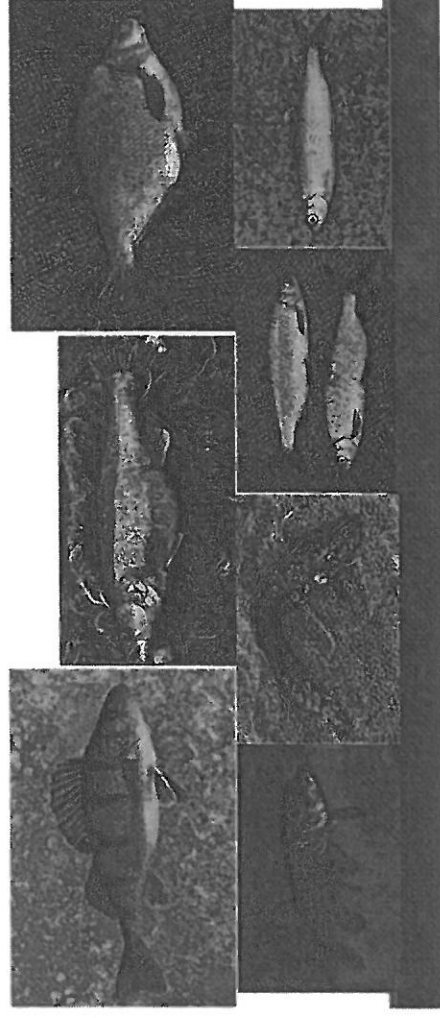

## Overview

- Lake Peipsi (Peipus) - 3 555 km<sup>2</sup> (Estonia 1 529 km<sup>2</sup>)
- 37 species of Fish
- The main catch for commercial fishing: perch, pike-perch, bream, pike, burbot, roaches, vendace; eel (smaller lakes)



## Development Association of Peipsi Fishery Area



- 2009-2013 - 14 project calls, over 200 projects submitted.
- Approval for 144 projects (total 4,1 mln €)
- Fishing ports – 32 projects (2,5 mln €)
- Direct marketing – 28 projects (0,3 mln €)
- Tourism - 58 projects (1,0 mln €)
- Diversification - 15 projects (0,2 mln €)
- Education - 11 projects (0,2 mln €)

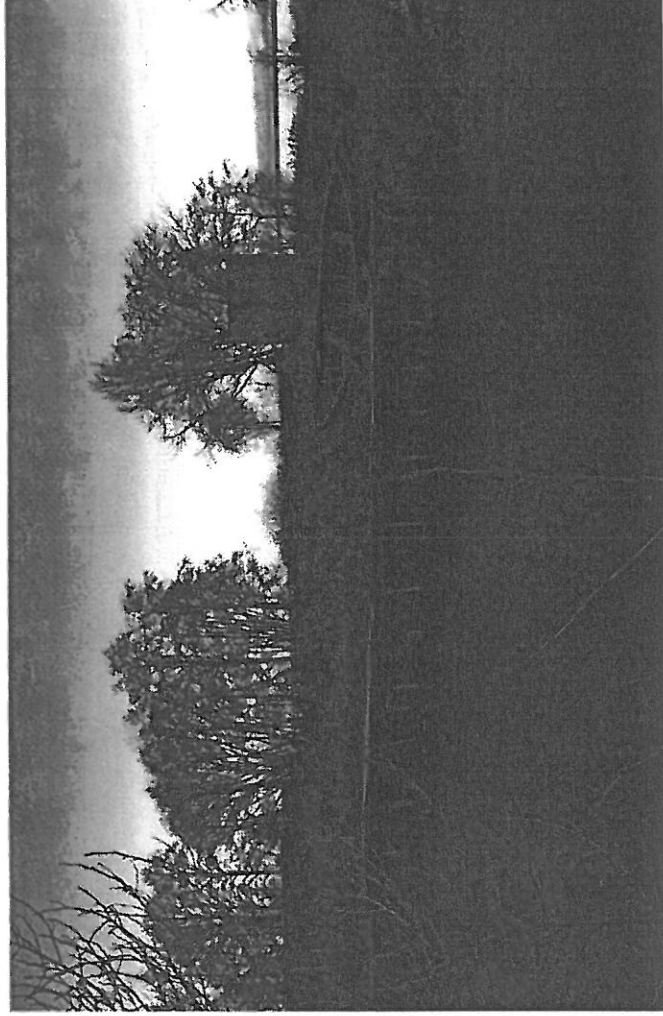

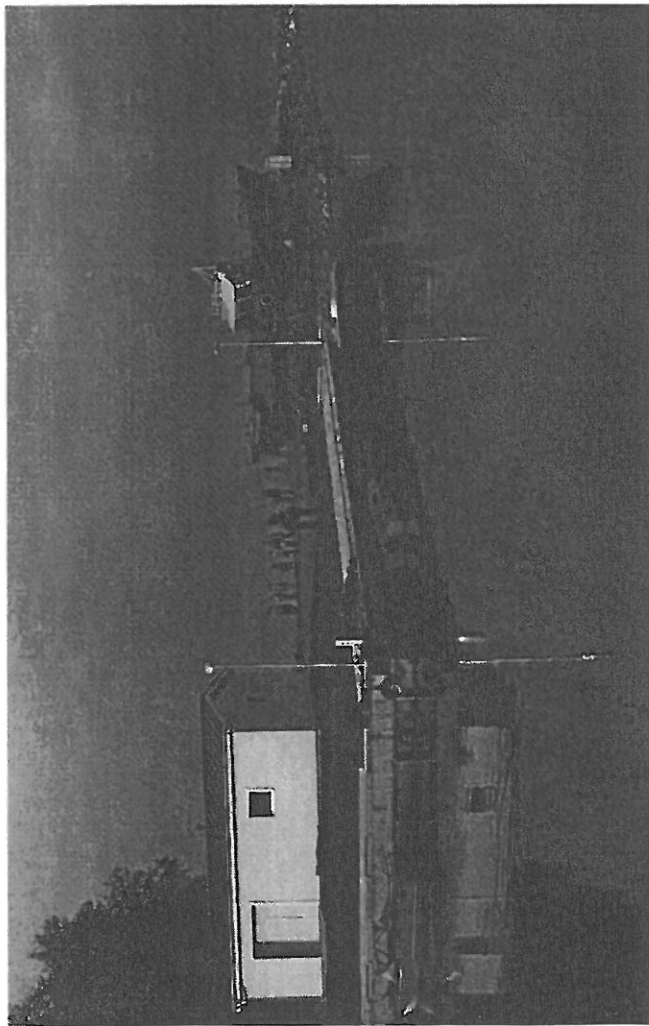

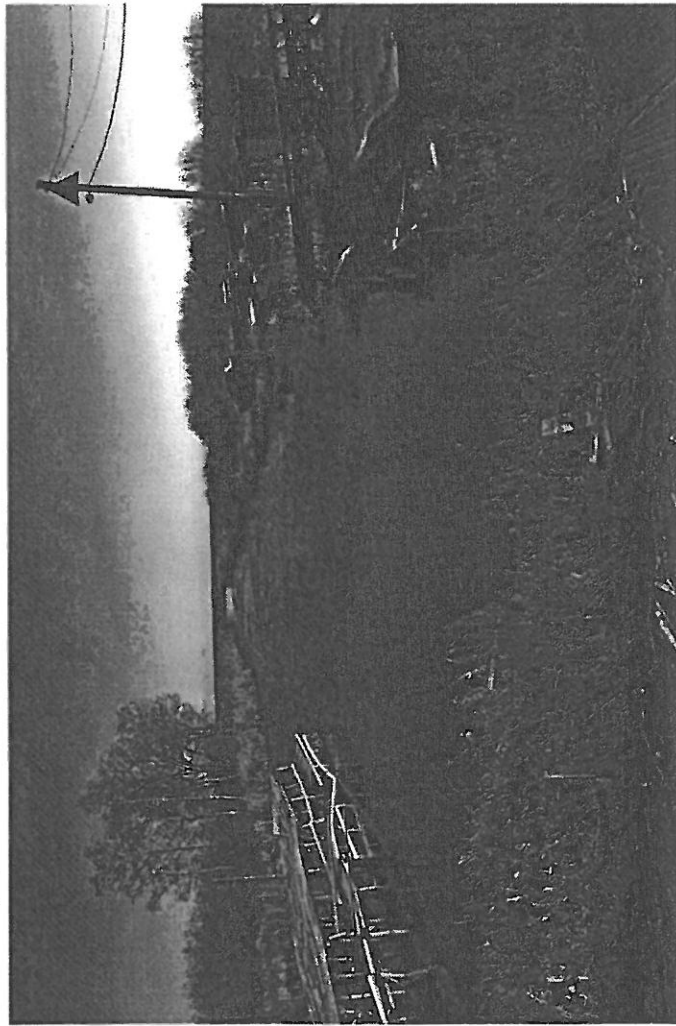
Sasukvere port 2008



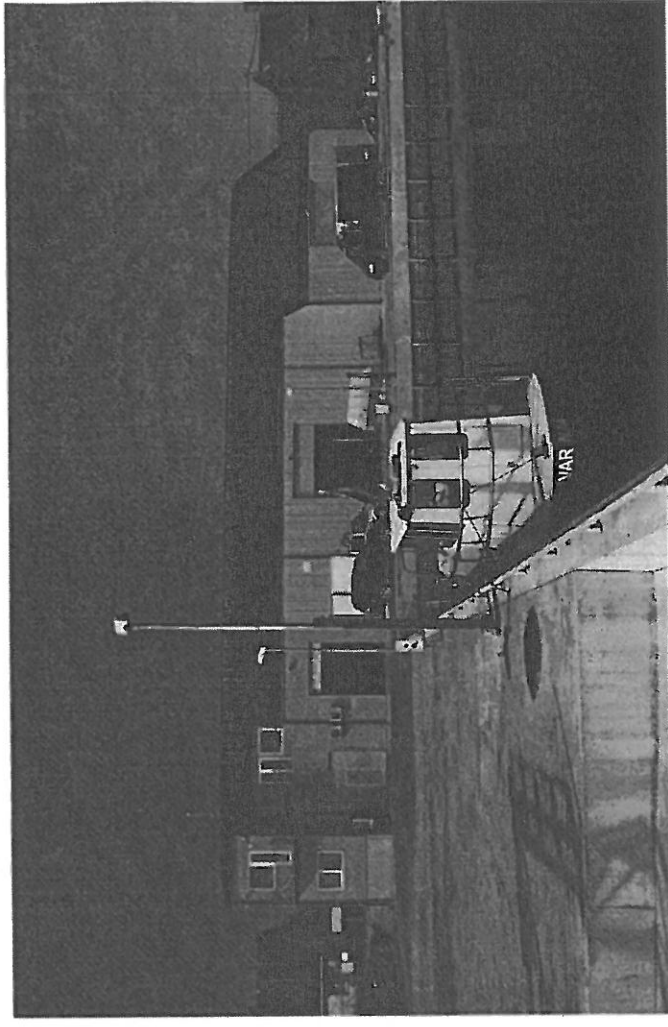

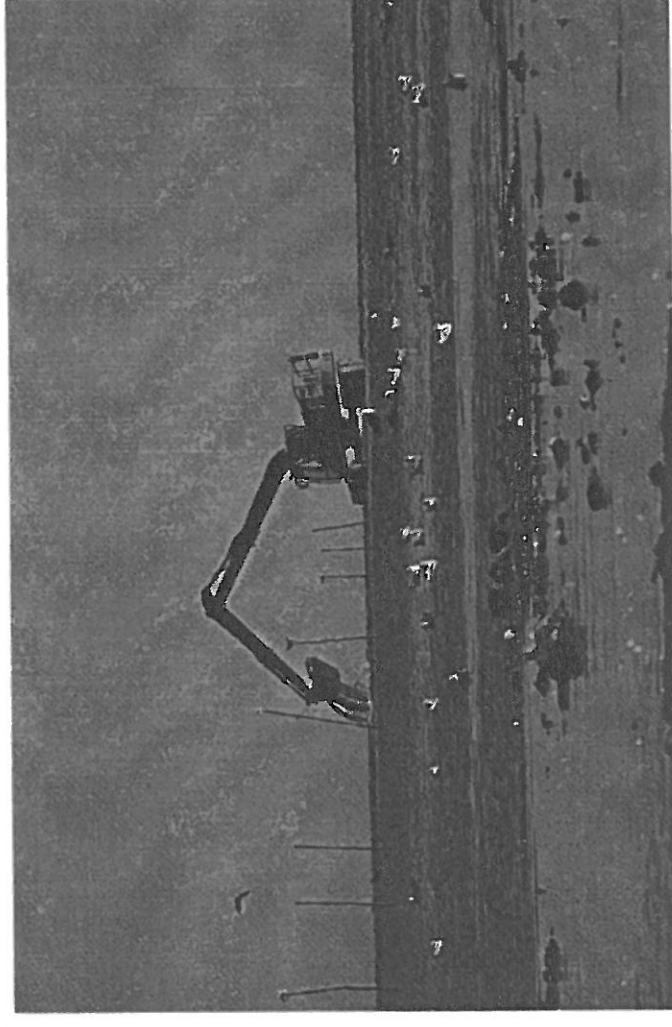

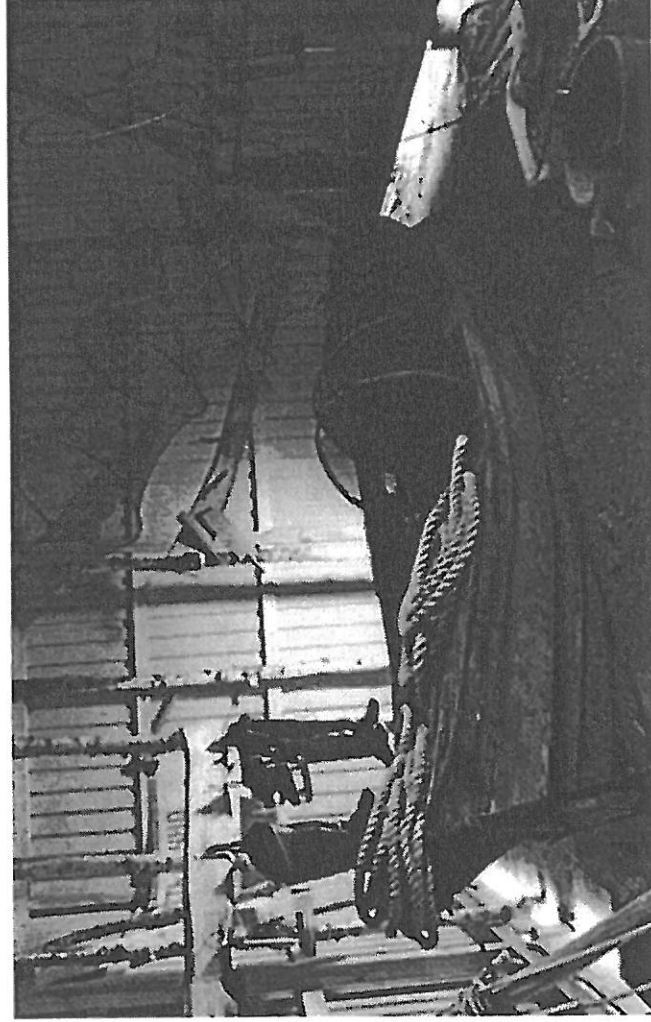

2 project calls for EMFF in a year (up to 2019)

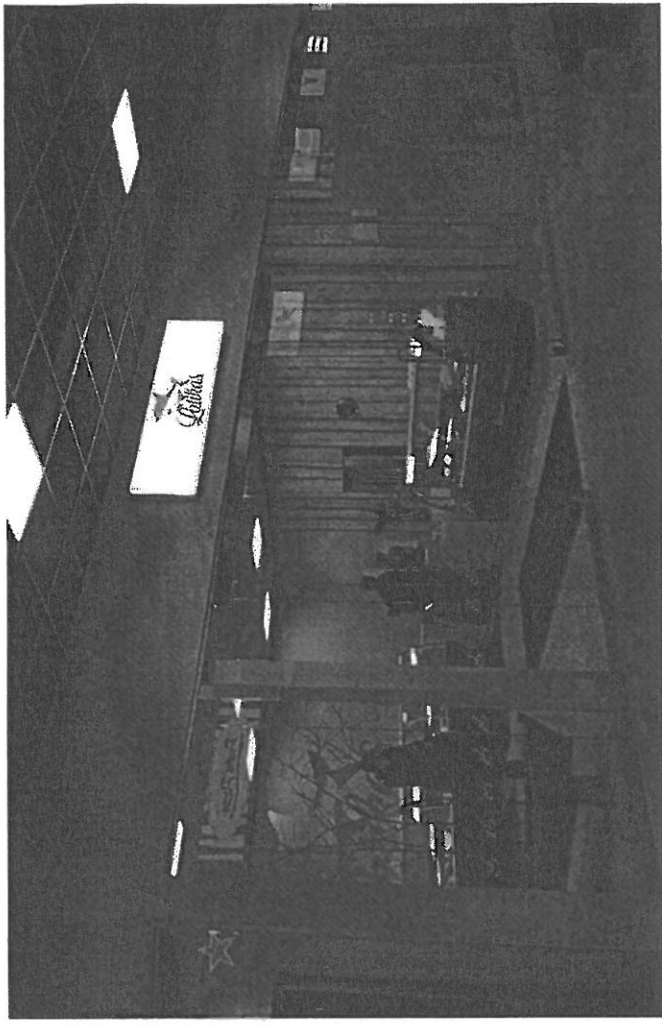

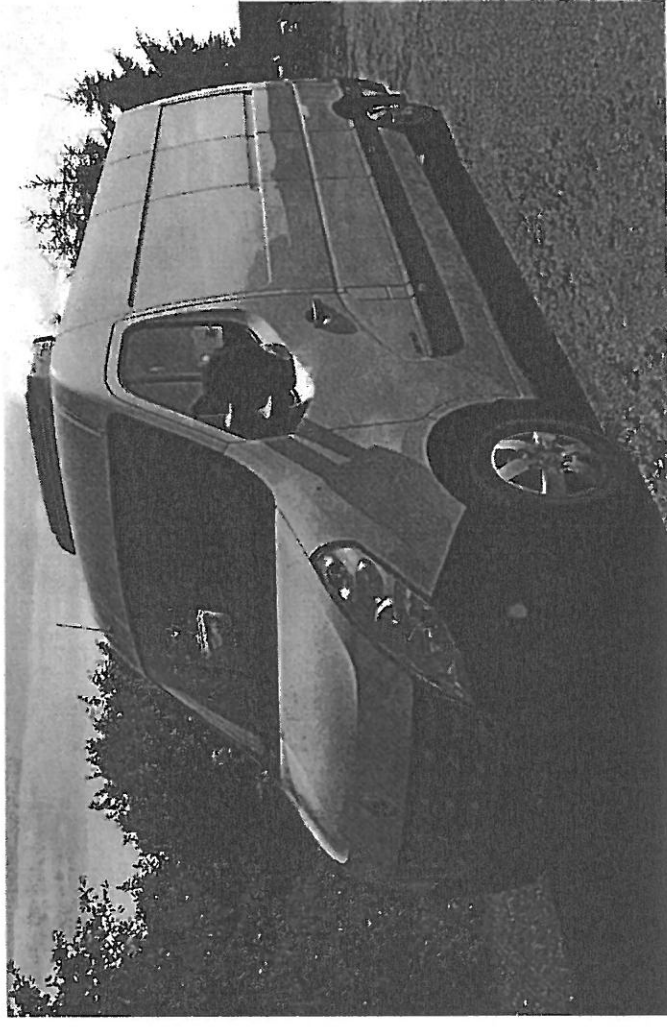

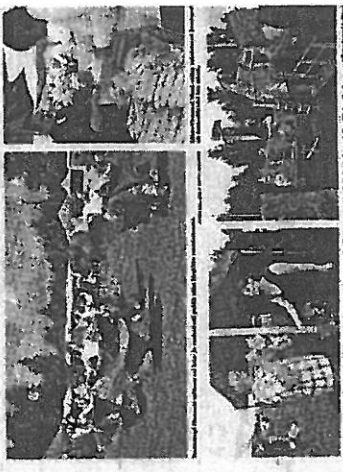
